Whereas Hon'ble Government of Himachal Pradesh vide No. Home C(C)1-5/2019 dated 01.09.2020 informed Himachal Pradesh Human Rights Commission, Pines Grove Building Shimla that two posts of Drivers on daily wages basis in Human Rights Commission be filled up on daily wages after adopting usual/approved mechanism.
2. Applications for two posts of drivers on daily wages are invited. Applications should reach in the office of H.P. Human Rights Commission on or before 26.10.2020 on prescribed performa available in the office of H.P. Human Rights Commission.
3. Terms & conditions of recruitment of two drivers on daily waged basis will be as follows:-
 - (i) Essential educational qualification will be matric pass from recognized Board of School Education.
 - (ii) Candidates must possess valid driving licence for plying of light vehicle in hilly terrain.
 - (iii) Candidate should have knowledge of custom, manners and dialects of Himachal Pradesh.
 - (iv) The age of candidate should be between 18 to 45 years. Relaxation of age will be permissible up to five years in case of SC & ST applicants as per instructions of Government of Himachal Pradesh.
 - (v) Application fee for general category will be Rs. 200/-(Two hundred) and Rs. 100/-(One hundred) for SC & ST category which will be deposited in

- (vi) Selection of two posts of drivers on daily wages will be made on the basis of merits of written examination covering syllabus of driving, maintenance skill of vehicle followed by practical test of driving. Passing of practical driving test shall be mandatory.
